

BEST PRACTICES STRATEGY AT VALKYR LODGES

Following are examples of how we intend to run ski trips at our lodges in 2021. These actions are based on directives issued by the Chief Public Health Officer of BC designed to prevent the transmission of the COVID-19 virus:

- 2-meter distance between people whenever possible
 - Masks to be worn when this is not possible
- Our large dining table will be removed and the living room furniture will be stowed
 - Smaller tables designed to accommodate 4 people spaced 2m apart
 - Lexan dividers will be placed on tables to create individual cubicles
 - Chairs and seating at table will be numbered according to room number and guests will keep the same seating all week
- Bedrooms will remain as double occupancy with guests in top and bottom bunks
 - Beds will have curtains to control cross contamination
 - Guests are asked to establish a flow so as not to crowd each other
 - Masks to be worn when distancing not possible
 - Windows will be partially open as fresh air is sighted as beneficial to preventing spread of virus
 - Each guest will have their own storage shelves and hooks
- Common area strategies
 - Spread out as much as possible; don't overload an area
 - Establish a schedule for specific activities where possible
 - Avoid loud talking (proven to spread more germs farther)
 - Be strategic in your movements
 - Communicate with others at the recommended distance of 2m
 - Use strict cough and sneeze etiquette
- Go with the Flow
 - Directional markers on floor will direct flow of foot traffic
 - One person at a time in stairways, hallways, bedrooms, doorways
- All Clean All the Time
 - All surfaces will be sanitized at least twice daily
- Dedicated staff only in kitchen
 - Take-out window using trays
 - Drinking water taps located in dining room to fill water bottles
- Staff and guests are asked to wash hands frequently and refrain from touching faces
